The Pembroke Project

The brief was to create open plan kitchen-living with a little bit of 'wow'. With this bold contrast and hand-painted finishes, it certainly hit the mark. Stunning solid surface, sleek high-end appliances, solid brass handles all topped off with an open bar pantry.







The Fairmilehead Project



An ultra modern and sleek German kitchen, incorporating functionality, dining and storage.

Originally separate kitchen and dining spaces, we removed the dividing walls and delivered a glorious open plan, flowing layout. The sink end with a floating base and lighting underneath ensures what could be a dull area is now light and airy.







The Farnley Project



A classic, traditional look but with contemporary highlights. This project features a lovely flowing L-shaped island, a tall housing run to accommodate the client's own American fridge-freezer and a tailored pantry for that finishing touch. The finishes work so well together.



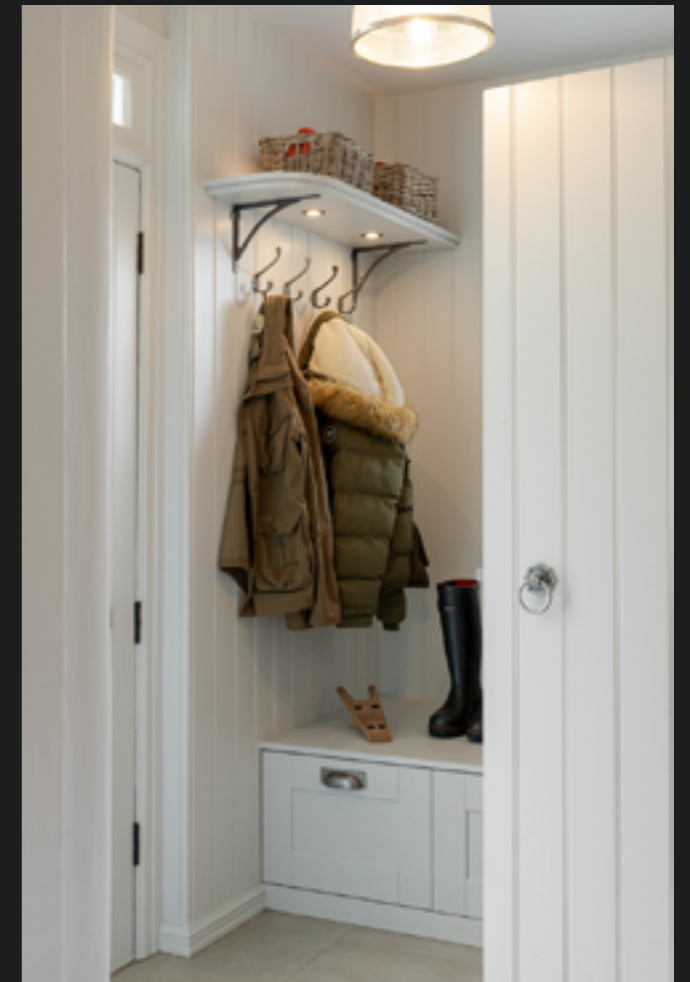


The Cottage Project

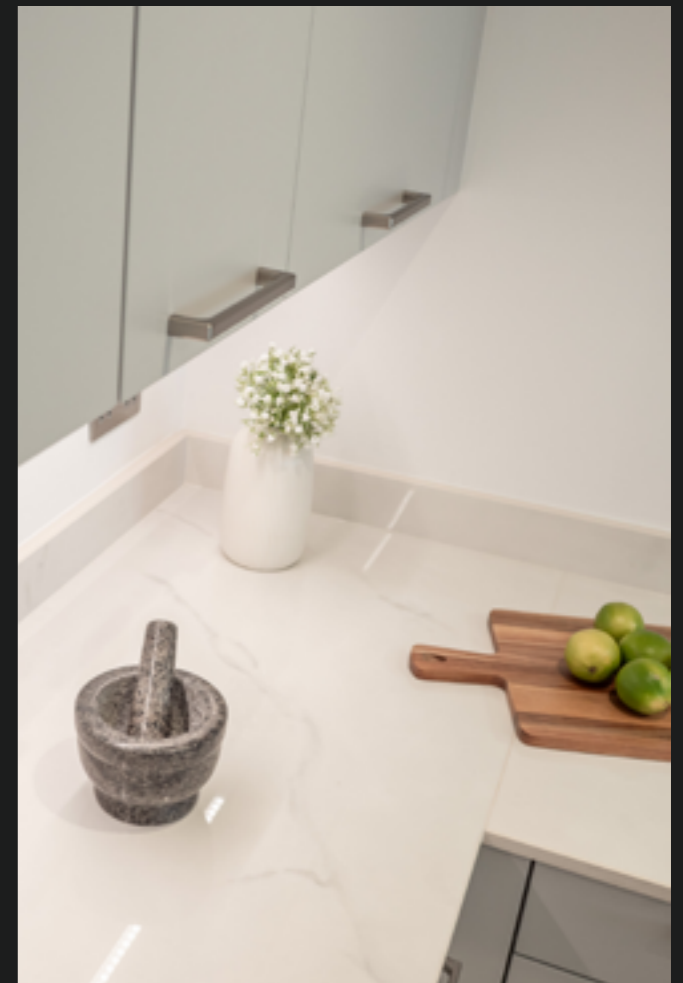


The Corstorphine Project

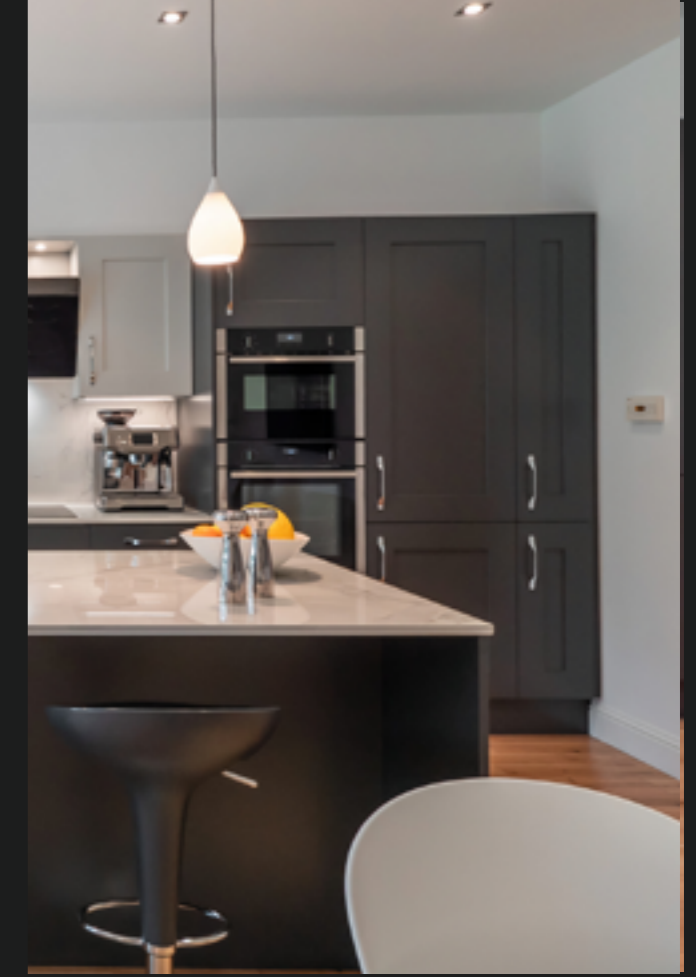




The Murrayfield Project



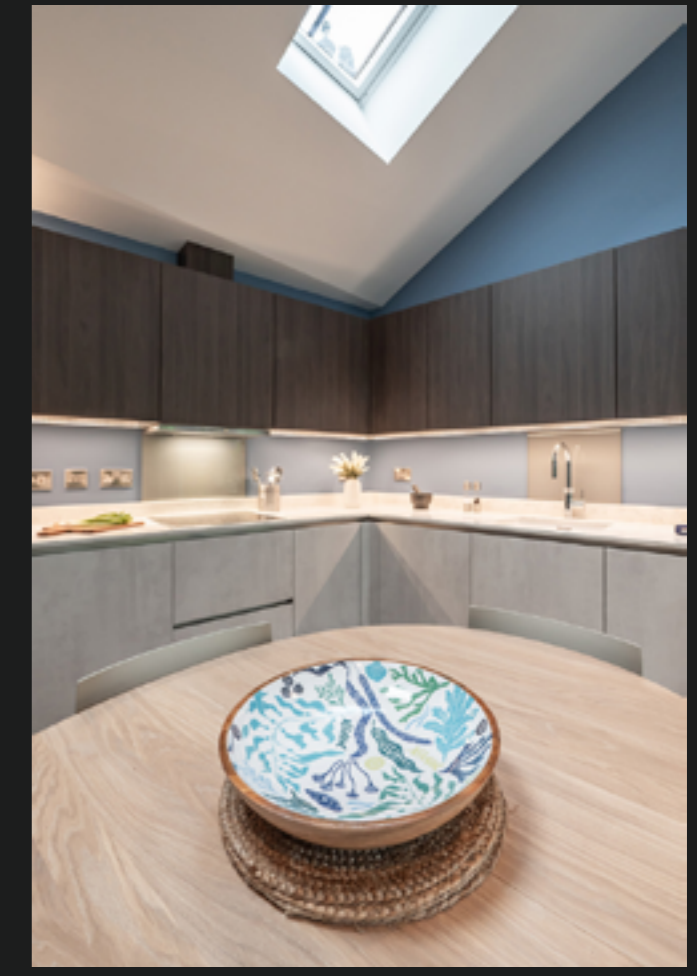

The Stocksbridge Project



This traditional Edinburgh stone-built mews conversion required bespoke angled wall planning solutions in both the kitchen & utility room, this was achieved without issue with our contemporary German product.

Tailored 135-degree shaped runs with two-tone rendered and woodgrain doors in a handleless design offered a sleek appearance in both rooms. In the kitchen seamless integration of lounge with dining spaces was critical for the open plan layout. The utility contained a bespoke tall laundry drying cupboard.





The Cousland Project

A stunning in-frame British kitchen. The client's brief was "no island – maximum worktops & storage". We followed the brief with the classic U shape. Lovely details such as a bespoke chimney hood, timber drawers, sleek glass wall units and elegant pewter handles bring the traditional layout to life.

It's a space that exceeds expectations in both beauty and functionality. The gloss work surfaces were that wow finishing touch.

The reduced design style of this kitchen, with its matt, dark finish will win over the minimalist in you. With its natural look, the vertical, lightly grained wood decor brings calm. Only counteracted by the dynamic pattern of the natural stone surfaces: an eye-catcher, practical and beautiful at the same time.

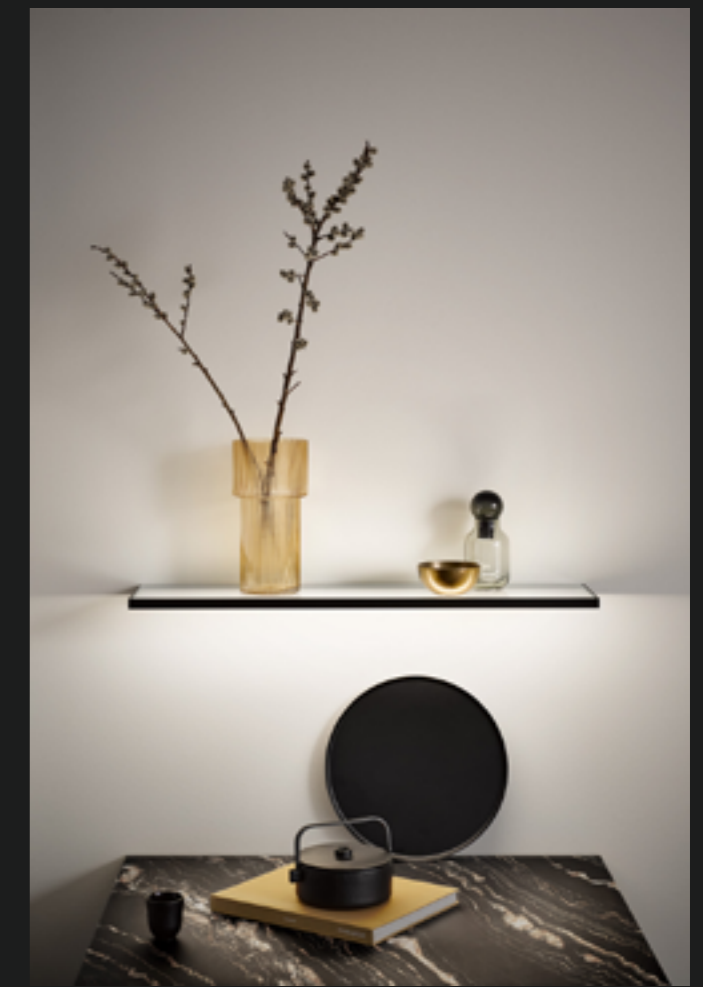


A particular highlight of this kitchen is the natural stone found on the worktops and back wall. The marbling brings both elegance and liveliness into this design.

The colour scheme of this timelessly beautiful kitchen is predominantly dark tones, combined with a few gold and brass-coloured accents. The handles create a colour transition between the black fine oak surfaces and the light marbling of the natural stone.



Many individual light sources discreetly create a homely atmosphere. All lighting elements in the kitchen act as indirect light sources, such as the spotlights that are integrated into the wall units.







A clear design statement. This handleless kitchen with breakfast bar achieves a blend of modern aesthetics, rustic charm, and cutting-edge technology. Scandinavian influences shine through, complemented by exclusive glass cabinets and captivating lighting effects, all accentuated by the authentic wood groove design.

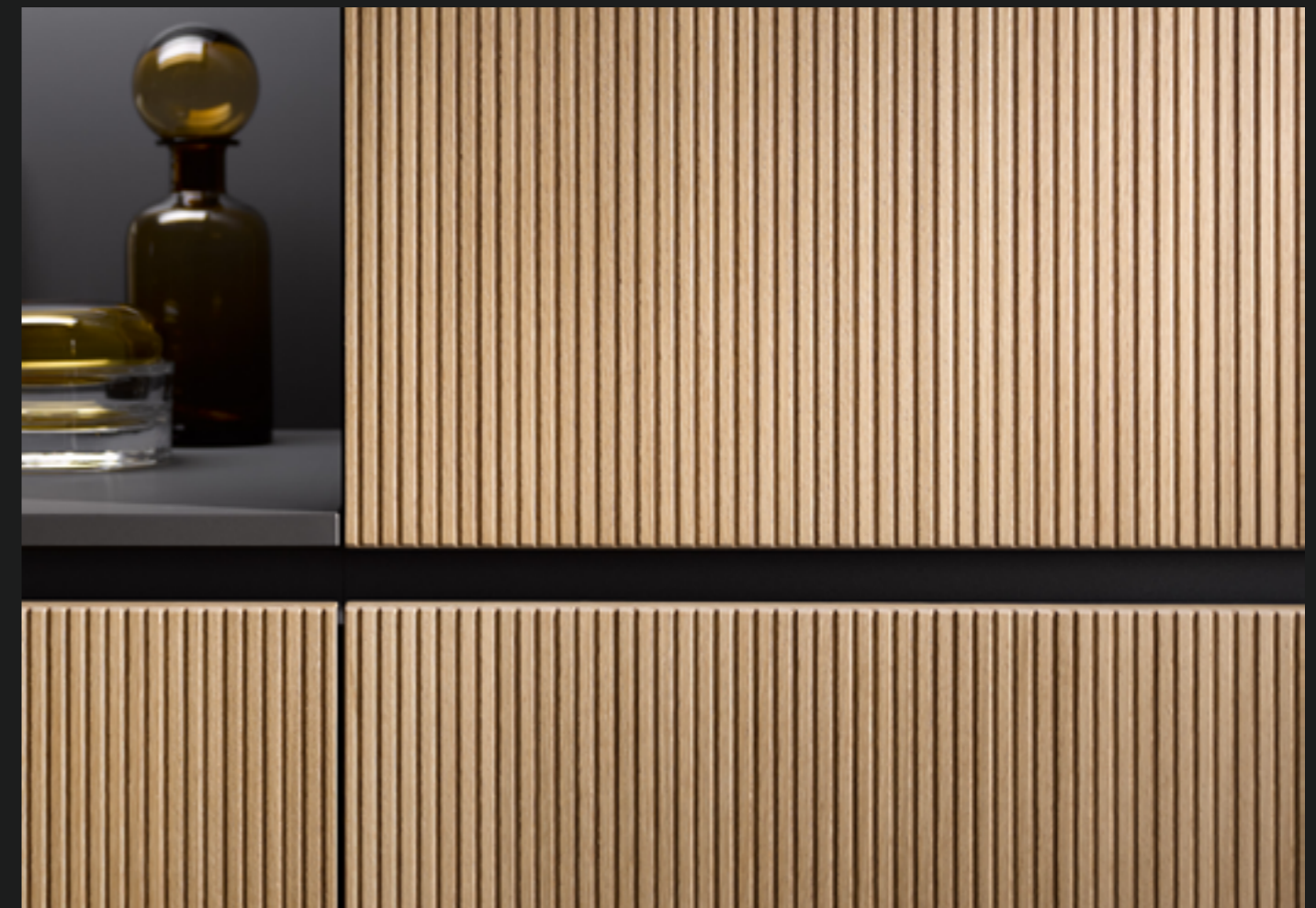


The kitchen worktops and splash-back are in a gorgeous graphite finish. The matte PerfectSense® surface is characterised by a velvety-soft feel and anti-fingerprint properties. Annoying marks don't stand a chance on the special UV matte varnish.

The tall unit creates a stunning focal point and seamlessly transitions the kitchen into the living area.



The oak grooved structure harmonises perfectly with the smoothly veneered surroundings. As a minimalist contrast to the warm wood tone, the pull-outs mouldings are in a cool graphite finish.







The art of intermediate tones. Greige, a subtle blend of grey and beige, complements other colours beautifully. In this kitchen, it highlights the fine marbling of the Calacatta surfaces, underlining the impression of this special kitchen.

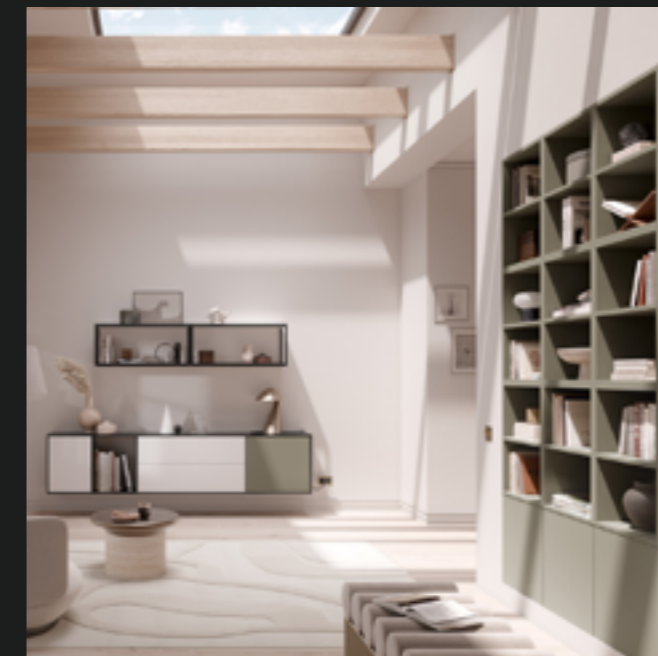
This exquisite kitchen impresses with its grace, elegance and aristocratic flair.

Here, the crystal white front blends seamlessly into the wall, while the grey seating area adds depth. Grey joints reinforce the straight-lined design, and gold handles complement the geometry.





This walnut kitchen pays modern homage to traditional walnut furniture. Its grooved surface showcases high-quality real wood veneer, complemented by sophisticated matt black and titanium accents. Rounded edges and smooth veneered surroundings add a soft touch.

The kitchen island. Everything about it is aesthetic and practical at the same time: from the flush installation of the sink and hob to the velvety soft, easy-care work surface in PerfectSense® quality to the pull-outs.





A standout feature of this stunning kitchen is the cube-shaped tall cabinet element, echoing the kitchen block's style and creating a cohesive room design with clear, expansive shapes. Behind the elegant walnut facade, the ceiling-high built-in units boast smart storage solutions, rendering wall cabinets unnecessary in this kitchen.

In the living area, the design continues with this elegant walnut sideboard.

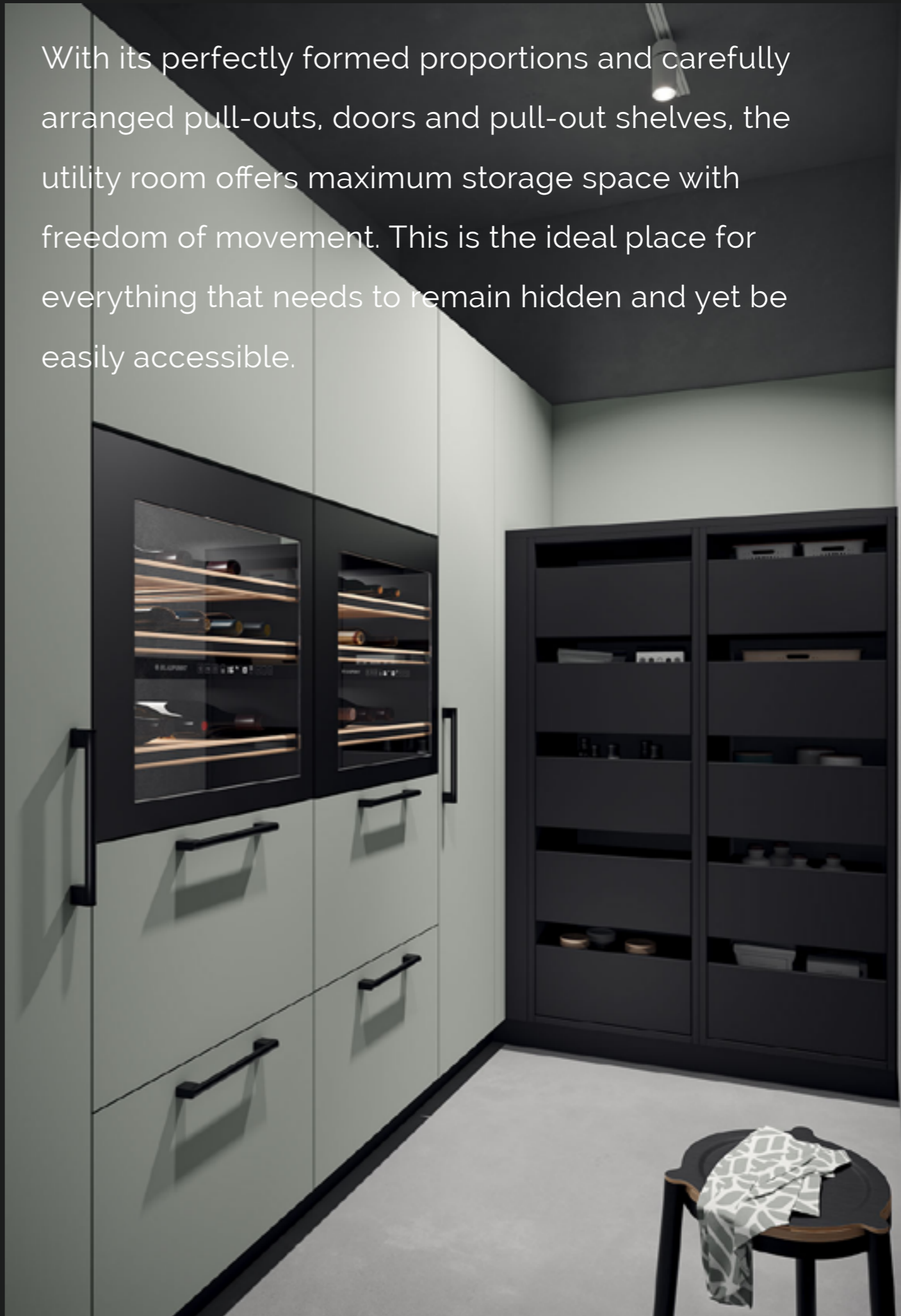

The protruding, cube-shaped kitchen island in crystal white forms the counterpoint to the terracotta-coloured tall cabinet unit.

It impresses not only with its enormous capacity, but also with its particularly thick natural stone worktop. Impressively beautiful and also highly practical, as it can hardly be scratched.

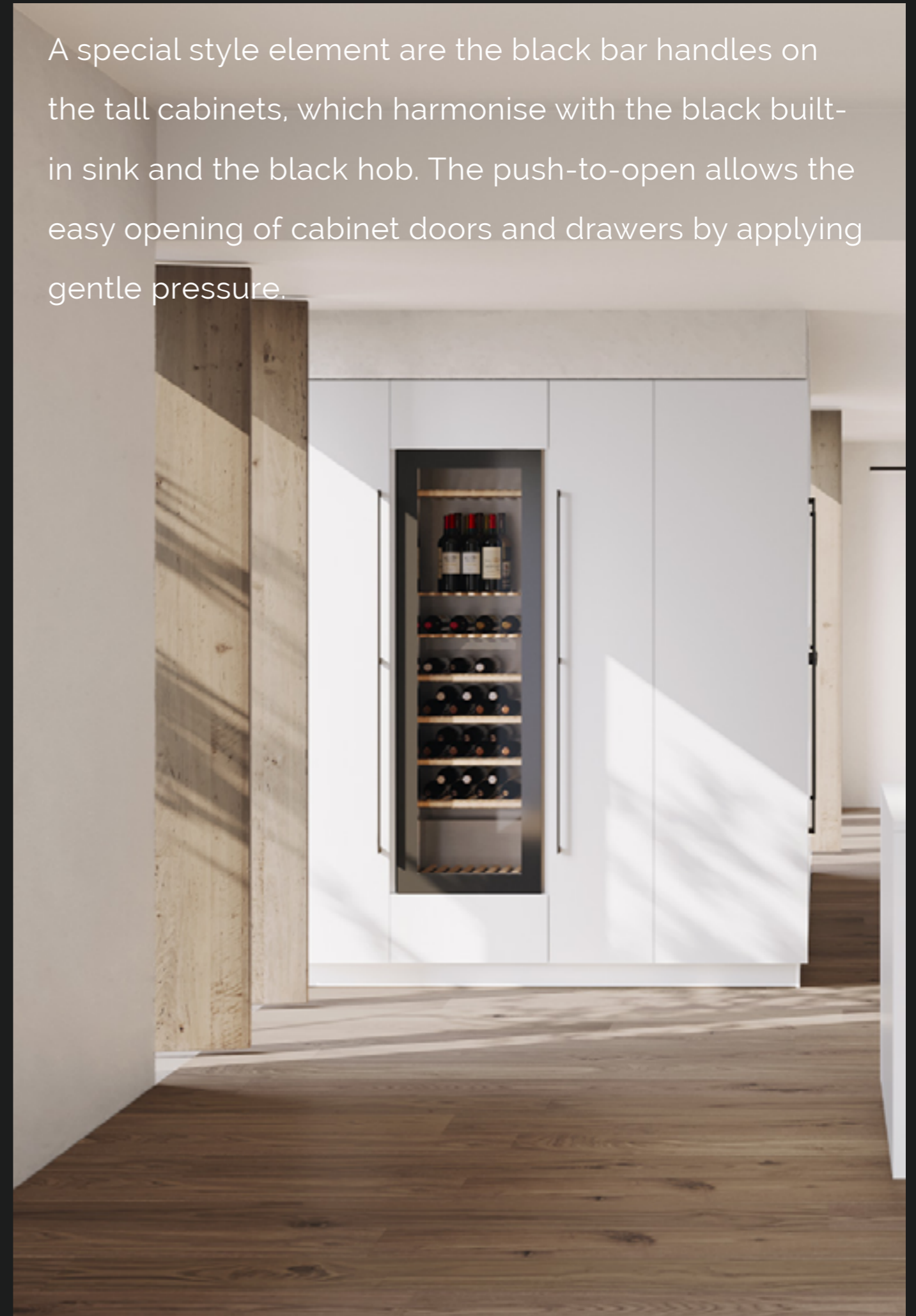

A special style element are the black bar handles on the tall cabinets, which harmonise with the black built-in sink and the black hob. The push-to-open allows the easy opening of cabinet doors and drawers by applying gentle pressure.



The dining table and sideboard also fit seamlessly into the minimalist overall concept of the kitchen. The steel skirt frame gives the dining table stability and, with its reduced, angular design, stands for clarity and concentration on the essentials. The tabletop is kept in crystal white like the front, which underlines the uniform look of the kitchen and dining area.

The larder unit features a tandem swivel pull-out. This means that the rear cabinet shelf slides towards you when opening the cabinet door. Since the door also features a shelf, you'll have all utensils immediately at hand with this smart cabinet solution.

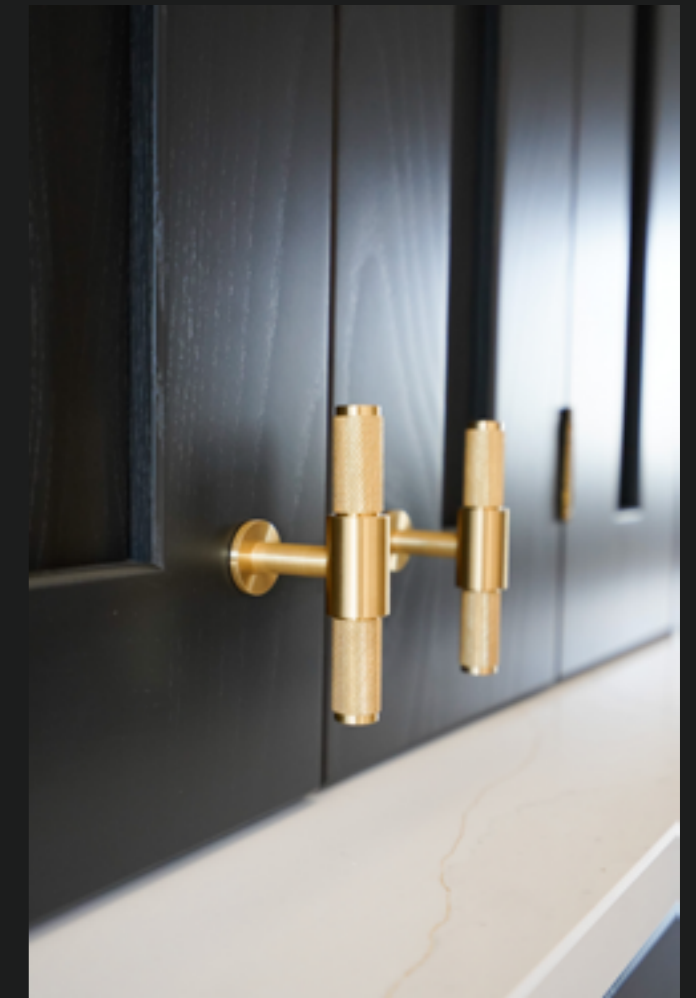
